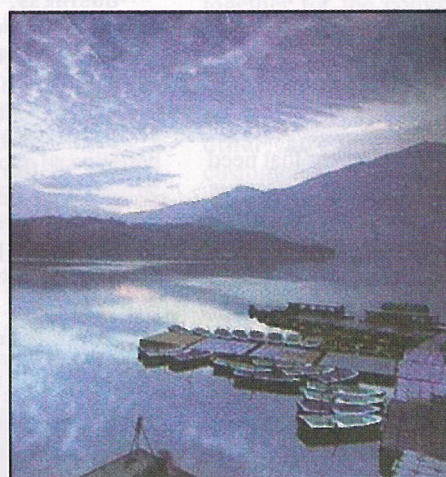




THE WONDERS OF TAIWAN

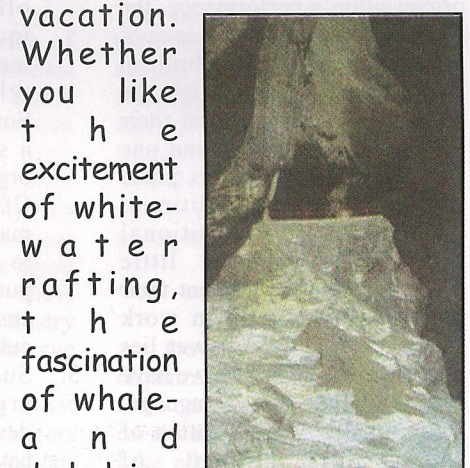
YILAN

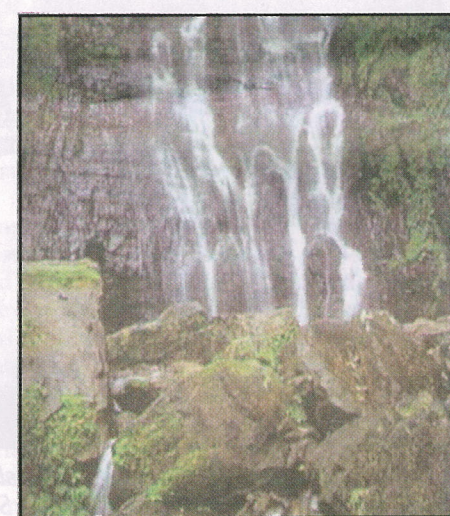


TAITUNG
